
Medicare and other government agencies will not call you unsolicitedly. If someone calls and says they're from Medicare, the IRS or the SSA, it's a scam.

Never accept medical equipment from unsolicited callers, even if they say it's free. You could be participating in healthcare fraud.

"If you don't cooperate, we'll suspend your benefits"



No legitimate government agency will threaten to suspend your benefits over the phone. If you feel threatened by an unsolicited caller, it's a scam.
